### FUND OBJECTIVE

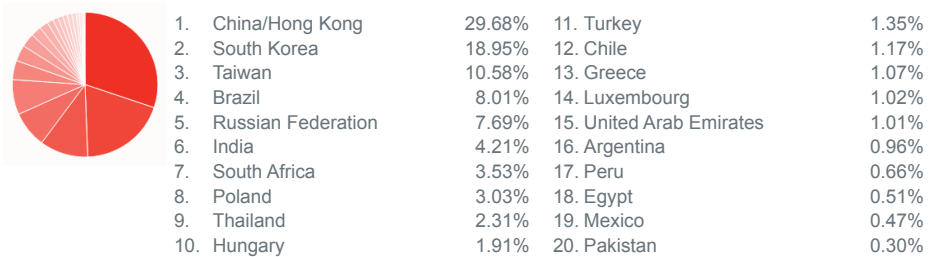

\* as percentage of NAV.

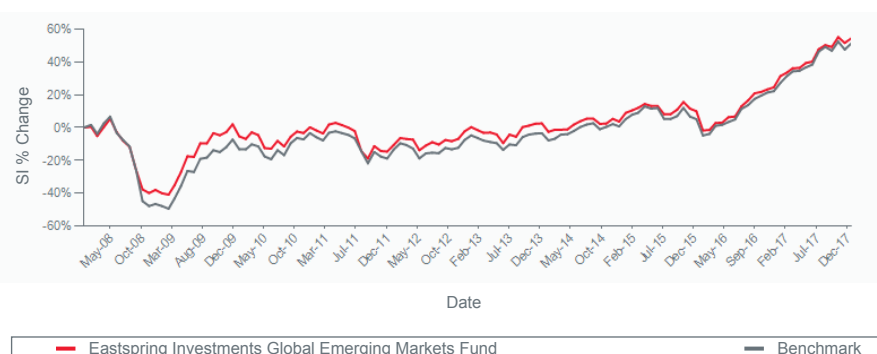

Lipper Leader ratings are derived from highly sophisticated formulas that analyse funds against clearly defined criteria. Each fund is ranked against its peers based on the metric used (such as Total Return or Expense), and then the top 20% of funds in that ranking receive the Lipper Leader designation. Lipper Leaders measures are not predictive of future performance, but they do provide context and perspective for making knowledgeable fund investment decisions.

### FUND MANAGER'S COMMENTARY

The fund returned 3.3% (A Acc Share class), underperforming the Morgan Stanley Capital International ("MSCI") Emerging Markets Index (+3.6%). On a gross underlying basis, the fund slightly outperformed, supported by positive stock selection.

Country allocation was negative with the underweight to South Africa and a zero-weight to Indonesia the key headwinds. These were partly offset by the overweight to Greece and underweight to Mexico.

At a stock level, selection in China added the most to relative returns. This included the overweight to brewer China Resources Beer. The stock rallied amid expectations that the company would raise prices on certain products. The overweights to private education provider New Oriental Education & Technology Group and China Mengniu Dairy also worked well. New oriental recovered following an earlier correction on margin concerns. Meanwhile, China Mengniu gained on expectations for an improvement in volume growth, alongside an improving competitive environment. Stock selection in Korea had a small positive impact, notably the overweight to Hana Financial Group. The bank rallied as the central bank moved to increase interest rates. An easing in concerns over government intervention was also beneficial.

Based on the Fund's portfolio returns as at 30 November 2017, the Volatility Factor (VF) for this Fund is 11.1 and is classified as "High" (Source: Lipper). "High" generally includes funds with VF that are higher than 8.225 but not more than 10.735. The VF means that there is a possibility for the Fund in generating an upside return or downside return around this VF. The Volatility Class (VC) is assigned by Lipper based on quintile ranks of VF for qualified funds. VF is subject to monthly revision and VC will be revised every six (6) months. The VF for the Fund may be higher or lower than the VC, depending on the market conditions. The Fund's portfolio may have changed since this date and there is no guarantee that the Fund will continue to have the same VF or VC in the future. Presently, only funds launched in the market for at least 36 months will display the VF and its VC.
