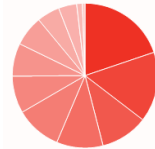

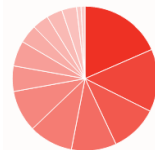

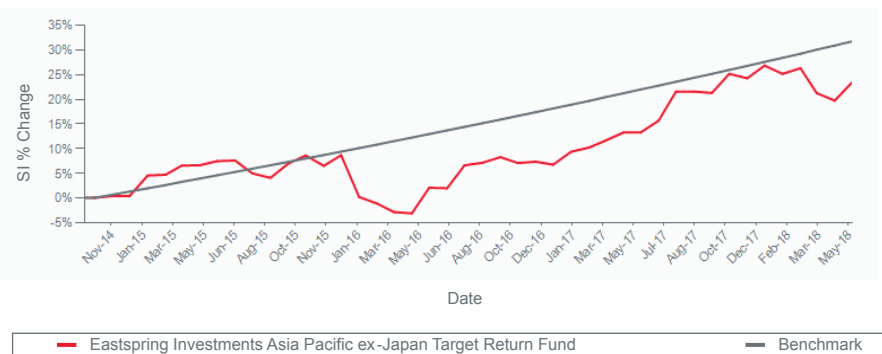

The Lipper Leaders Ratings System is a set of tools that guide investors and their advisors to select funds that suit individual investment styles and goals. Each fund is ranked against its peers based on the metric used (such as Total Return or Expense), and then the top 20% of funds in that ranking receive the Lipper Leader designation. Lipper Leaders measures are not predictive of future performance, but they do provide context and perspective for making knowledgeable fund investment decisions.

FUND MANAGER'S COMMENTARY

The Fund registered a positive return of 3.07% in May ahead of the target rate of return of +0.64% (8%pa compounded), on the back of stock selection gains in Chinese healthcare stocks and Malaysian stocks.

Markets fell in the month of May, with the MSCI Asia ex-JP index falling by 1.21% in USD terms. Losses occurred across most regions within Asia Pacific, with ASEAN countries faring the worst as foreign outflows picked up pace on the back of a stronger US Dollar and rising US interest rates. The backdrop of higher crude oil prices also did not bode well for countries such as India and Indonesia with macro fundamentals under pressure.

Key events were the US pulling out of the Iran nuclear deal signed in 2015 and reinstating sanctions on the country, triggering an upwards move in oil prices. The news surrounding a US-China trade war continued as both countries engaged in talks to reduce the bilateral trade deficit. In ASEAN, Malaysia's incumbent government surprised markets by losing the election causing further market volatility while both Indonesia and Philippine Central Banks moved to hike benchmark interest rates on the back of a weakening currency and rising price pressures respectively.

Based on the Fund's portfolio returns as at 30 April 2018, the Volatility Factor (VF) for this Fund is 8.6 and is classified as "High" (Source: Lipper). "High" generally includes funds with VF that are higher than 7.975 but not more than 10.615. The VF means that there is a possibility for the Fund in generating an upside return or downside return around this VF. The Volatility Class (VC) is assigned by Lipper based on quintile ranks of VF for qualified funds. VF is subject to monthly revision and VC will be revised every six (6) months. The VF for the Fund may be higher or lower than the VC, depending on the market conditions. The Fund's portfolio may have changed since this date and there is no guarantee that the Fund will continue to have the same VF or VC in the future. Presently, only funds launched in the market for at least 36 months will display the VF and its VC.
